Glossary

Dementia Nursing - A care facility that can look after people living with dementia who have high needs / challenging behaviour (Previously known as EMI - Elderly Mentally Infirm)

Nursing Home - A nursing home has a full-time registered nurse on duty, round the clock. This is the type of home that may be needed if a person has a condition that requires nursing intervention, for example: Injections, complex wound dressings or other complex needs. People with catheters, hoisting needs, peg feeding etc can often be cared for at home or in a residential care home.

Respite Care - Short-term care, usually 2 - 8 weeks

Safeguarding Team - This is a central point for advice and support in relation to Adult Safeguarding. The team receives referrals, from public or professional, that relate to concerns of abuse and neglect for over 18s and screens these against the 3 criteria.
